63. What is forbidden in the fourth commandment?

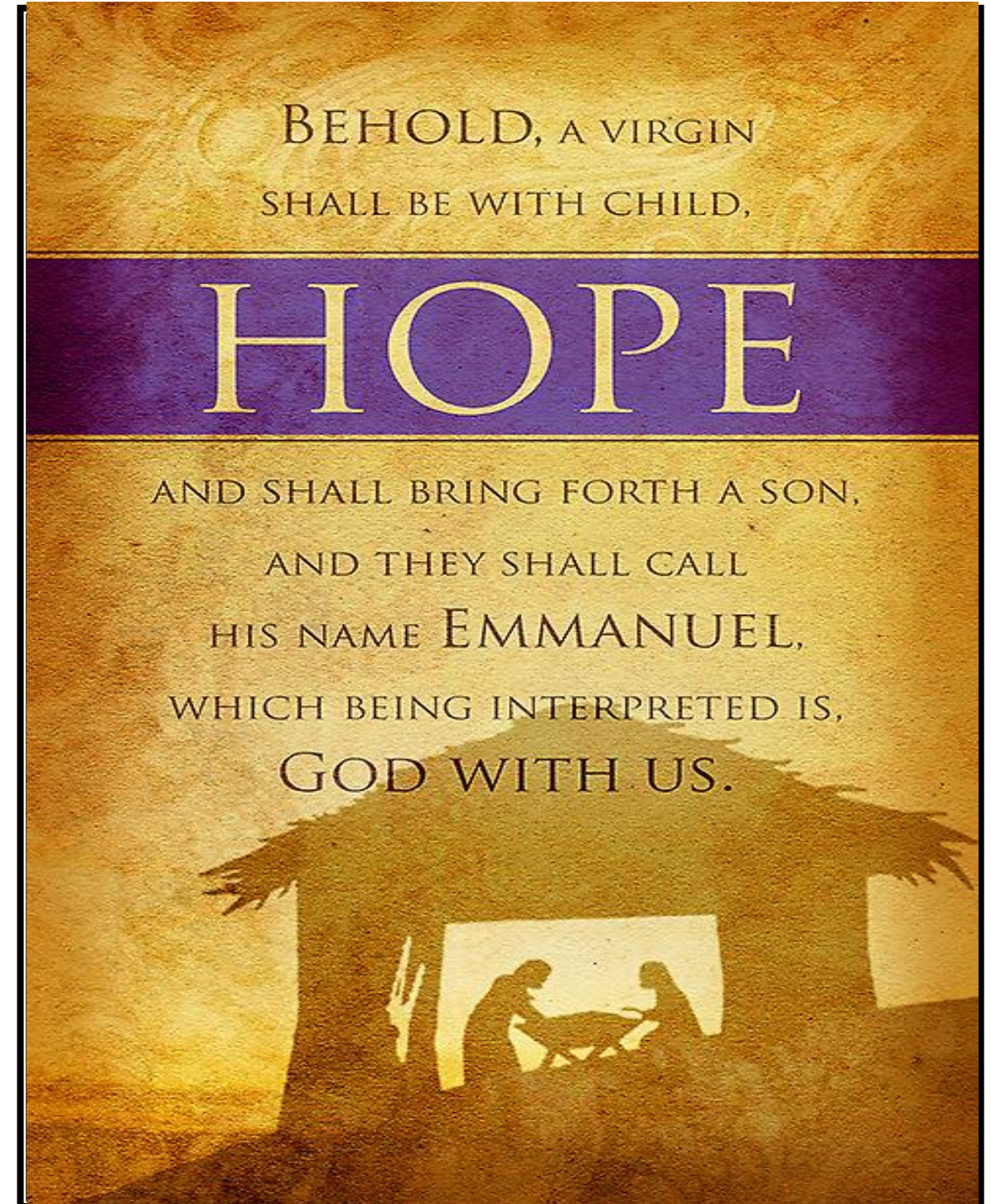
