God's works of providence are His preserving and so governing His creatures, and overruling their actions, as to manifest His wisdom, power, and goodness in promoting their welfare.

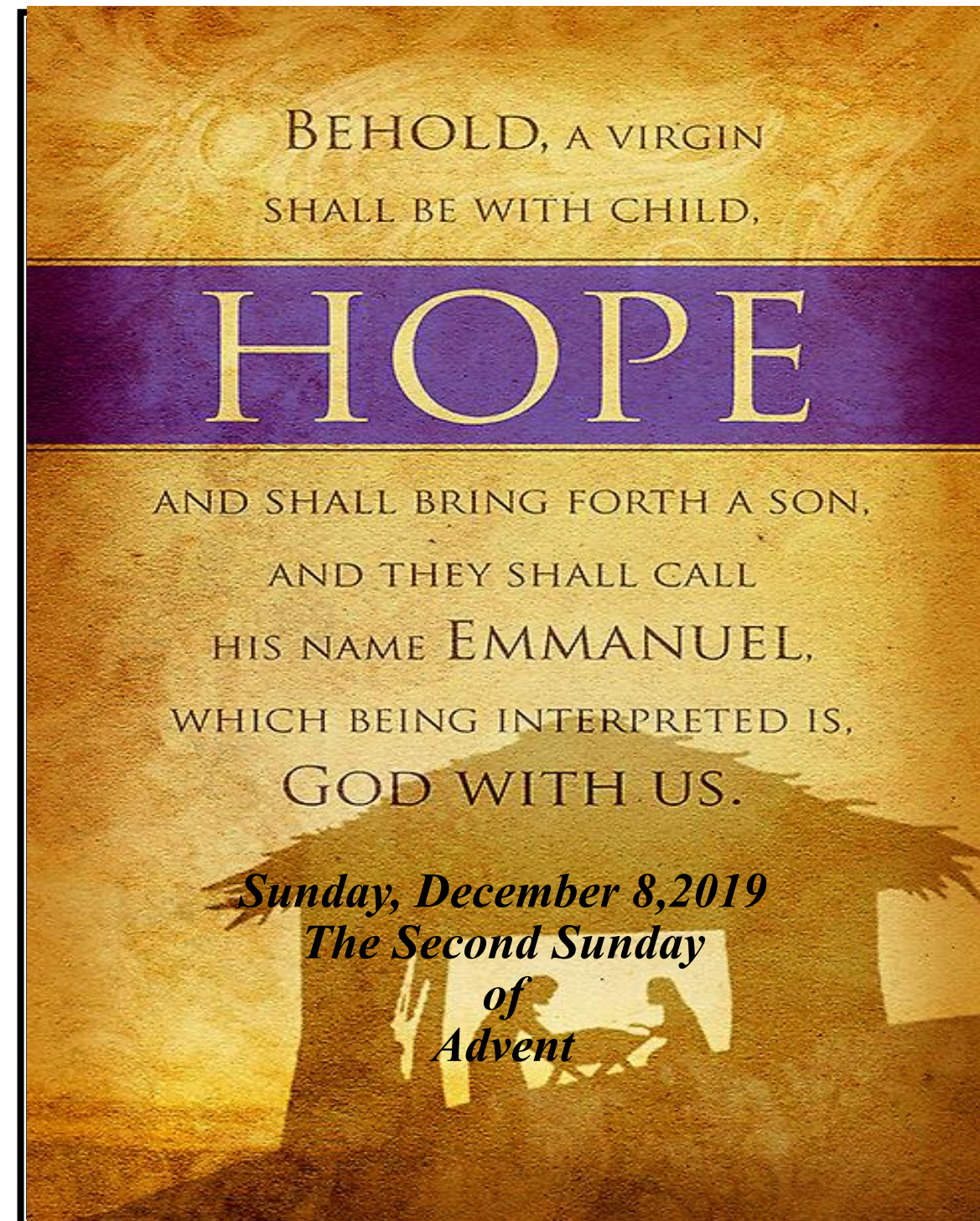
